

Catholic School Tuition Assistance

Currently we have more than 15,000 students in our diocesan Catholic schools, and there is more than \$6 million in identified need for tuition assistance. The diocese is only able to fund 7% of the need right now, or about \$850,000 per year. Many of the families who truly need help paying for tuition don't receive any aid at all or not nearly enough because there is simply not enough funding.

There are many families with multiple children in Catholic schools, or they might have college tuition bills as well. Some of these families have to make tough choices and sacrifices in order to allow their child access to a quality, faith-filled education at one of our Catholic schools. Others are simply not able to make it work, and have to decide not to send their kids to Catholic schools.

It is part of our mission as the Catholic church to educate and evangelize our children. We want to bring Catholic families in and ensure that the tuition cost is not a barrier to attend our schools. We need your help so that every family who would like to send their children to our Catholic schools is able to afford to do so.
